OCHF Health Care Scholarships Available

Applications are now being accepted for health care scholarships being offered by the Partners of Osceola Medical Center and the Osceola Community Health Foundation. These scholarships were established to provide financial assistance to residents of Osceola and the surrounding areas. To be eligible, applicants should be accepted at an accredited educational institution and pursuing a health-related career.

Partners of Osceola Medical Center

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to a current high school senior and an adult student who are beginning or continuing post-secondary education in a health-care field.

Osceola Community Health Foundation Scholarship

A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior at Osceola and St. Croix Falls High Schools pursuing a degree in a health-care field.

Osceola Medical Center Physicians Scholarship

A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior at Osceola High School pursuing a degree in a health-care field.
