Foundation presents check to Skate Park

The local fundraising organization, Osceola Mainstreet Skate Park, recently received more than \$1,500 in grant awards from the Osceola Community Health Foundation.

“With the help from giveBIG Osceola and OCHF’s matching funds in 2014, we have made a step in the right direction to see our vision become reality,” said Funding Coordinator, Paul Anderson. “The skate park structure will be a dual use park for skateboarders and BMX bicycles – two popular activities that can build strength, courage and enhanced quality of life for its participants,” he adds. The estimated total budget for this project is \$120,000. The initial push for the skate park began with a commitment of land in Oakey Park and \$15,000 from the Village of Osceola. With donations from OCHF the fundraising efforts are headed in a positive direction but the project is still in need of financial support.

The Osceola Mainstreet Skate Park is one of many nonprofit organizations participating in this year’s giveBIG Osceola. giveBig is a 24-hour fundraising event April 29 where St. Croix Valley communities come together to give to area nonprofit
